

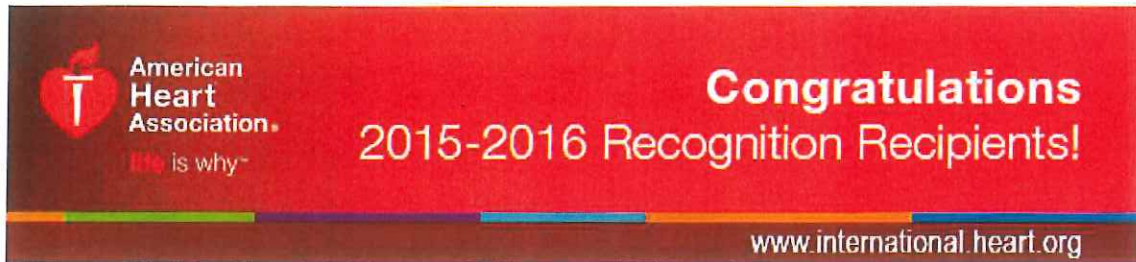

Award of Merit 2015 - 2016
Fortis Hospitals Noida

A decade ago, the Fortis Hospital of Noida became an AHA International Training Center (ITC) and began establishing a deep connection within the Delhi community. This connection has transformed into a meaningful relationship thanks to the efforts of Training Center Coordinator and active physician, Dr. Dina Shah and his team. In fact, Dr. Dina, has personally conducted over 70 lifesaving courses as a director while building 3 training sites under the International Training Center (ITC) of Noida. This ITC now has 10 training sites and almost 59 instructors trained.

Most cardiac arrest events occur outside a hospital – like at work or at home, so training more bystanders in the steps to save a life means a better chance of survival for cardiac arrest victims. Fortis Hospitals Noida understands that the chain of survival is strengthened when more people in all parts of a community know CPR, and their staff has continued that commitment today by expanding lifesaving training beyond hospitals and medical schools, to local and corporate communities. Dr. Dina also conducts monthly group trainings in nearby residential societies, corporate offices, and with the Traffic Police Noida as part of the hospitals' Corporate Social Responsibility activities. Fortis Hospitals has also hosted "flash mob" trainings in malls in Noida and training sites in Punjab – reaching more than 7000 community members.

The Fortis Hospitals of Noida has demonstrated a high commitment to not only the AHA standards and guidelines, but to its community involvement and dedication to saving lives. For exemplifying the commitment to quality training, for going above and beyond to train more people in more places we celebrate Fortis Hospitals Noida with the Award of Merit.
